The city-wide average of a baby bottle filled with coins, cash or checks is \$25. Talk with your family about how much each would like to give, involve the kids! We have baby bottles and envelopes for this on the table in the vestibule. Fill the bottle with change or a check and return to St. John Chrysostom. The bottles will be returned to PDHC after Father's Day.

This campaign will run from Mother's Day, May 12<sup>th</sup>, through Father's Day, June 16<sup>th</sup>.

**THE HELPING HANDS HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER** is a free medical clinic for folks who are uninsured or underinsured. Many medical and non-medical volunteers make this a beautiful place of healing.

Helping Hands Health and Wellness Center adheres to the Catholic Health Care Directives, including all Pro-Life teachings.

614-262-5094. The Free Care Program is currently offered twice a week. There is also a Women's Health Program which runs monthly; and physical exams and TB skin testing as well as other services are available.



Our main initiative is to make sure that Catholics are praying and offering help from

the sidewalk every hour the two abortion facilities in central Ohio are open. 10 babies are aborted every day in our city on average. When Christians are there 1 out of every 50 mothers cancel their appointment! We have seen 121 mothers leave and babies be rescued! More children depend on you!

Catholics for Life, Greater Columbus Right to Life, and other ministries can provide training, literature, signs, and shadowing opportunities.
