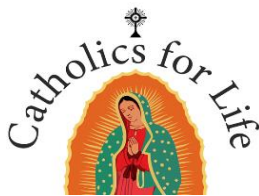
Helping Hands Health and Wellness Center adheres to the Catholic Health Care Directives, including all Pro-Life teachings.

It is located at 5100 Karl Road, Columbus, 43229. Phone number is 614-262-5094. The Free Care Program is currently offered twice a week. There is also a Women's Health Program which runs monthly; and physical exams and TB skin testing as well as other services are available.

CATHOLICS FOR LIFE is a Columbus-based apostolate organizing pro-life and evangelization events to equip Catholics for life-saving missionary work.

We lead larger events every First Thursday and Third Saturday. Sign up for updates at www.CatholicsForLife.us

Our main initiative is to make sure that Catholics are praying and offering help from the sidewalk every hour the two abortion facilities in central Ohio are open. 10 babies are aborted every day in our city on average. When Christians are there 1 out of every 50 mothers cancel their appointment! We have seen 121 mothers leave and babies be rescued! More children depend on you!

Catholics for Life, Greater Columbus Right to Life, and other ministries can provide training, literature, signs, and shadowing opportunities. There are only

10 monthly and weekly shifts that are left uncovered at Planned Parenthood (3255 E. Main St.). Shifts are regularly updated at www.CatholicsForLife.us.
